The All Access Pass provides access to everything streamed live from the tournament. Sometimes there are issues and buffering on a game or two, or the cameraman gives a bad performance, or something really exciting happens and the camera-turn is too slow. This happens unfortunately and could happen at every tournament.

The live stream also offers the opportunity to watch and analyze the game afterwards. A great extension of the service not only for spectators, but also for the participating clubs.

### Abschnitt (c) Medical care

The organizer assumes no liability for any injuries!

There is a first aid station in the tournament center in the Wiener Stadthalle. A team of emergency doctors and paramedics provide first aid there. If necessary, the ambulance is notified, and the patient is taken to a nearby hospital for further treatment.

Each participant is responsible for covering the costs of medical care themselves. The European Health Insurance Card is recognized in Austria. It is a free card that entitles you to medically necessary public health services during a temporary stay in one of the 28 EU countries as well as Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland - under the same conditions and at the same cost (free in some countries) as those insured in the respective country. The card is issued by your statutory health insurance provider.

Important: The European Health Insurance Card ...

- is not a substitute for travel insurance. It does not include private healthcare or other costs that you may incur (e.g. return flight to your home country, replacement of lost or stolen property).
- does not cover your costs if you travel specifically for the purpose of receiving medical treatment.
- does not guarantee free treatment. The health systems of each country are different. It is therefore possible that services for which you do not have to pay in your own country may be subject to payment in other countries.

The age groups U22 and U24 no longer exist.

The age groups were introduced after Corona to give the teams that could not come in 2020 the opportunity to catch up on their participation.

We are basically a youth tournament and would like to stick with this core competency. Many of our regulations and tournament rules are not suitable for older players. It is important to us that everyone who takes part in our tournament goes home with great experiences that are suitable for them. We cannot guarantee this for adult teams. Therefore, these age groups will no longer be offered 2 years after the Corona break!

#### Abschnitt (b) Proof of age

Each player has to have a photo ID to verify his/her age (no copies!). We accept passports/travel ID or driving licences only. The official roster signed from the national association is valid for Austrian citizens only. All non-Austrian citizens have to provide a valid passport or identity card.

Other national licenses will not be accepted.

Within the qualifying round the gym supervisor can request to see the ID's of all players. Please hand them over until the game is finished. Please prepare all ID's for the supervisor for all cross-plays. Players that cannot prove their age by a legal document are not eligible to play. The organization will not take a game into account for any placements in which a player that is not allowed to play plays anyway.

Each player is only allowed to play in **one team per age group**. (For example, a player can play in the MU14 and MU16 of his club, but he may not play with the MU14/1 and MU14/2 of his club.)

#### Unterpunkt 3.02 Tournament rules

##### Abschnitt (a) The number of participating teams is limited as follows.

In order to be able to offer a high-quality tournament, it has become necessary to limit the number of registered teams per age group. The number of teams listed in the table below will be accepted per age group:

##### Abschnitt (b) Age groups with color coded groups

We'll divide the teams into 4 pools of equal size (RED / BLUE / GREEN / YELLOW), whereby there will be no separation in terms of performance. Teams from the same country will be split evenly across the pools and we will separate teams from the same region where possible. Each pool is divided into groups of 4 or 5, which play „everyone against everyone“ in the group phase, after which it continues in the KO system.

The winners of the 4 pools qualify for the semi-finals / finals. There will no longer be a low mode, as in previous years.

Of course, friendly games can be organized during the tournament week (if halls are available).

#### Abschnitt (c) All other age groups

For all other age groups with fewer registered teams the following game mode applies:

Teams will be put into groups of 4 or 5 and play against each other. All teams that reach the first or the second place in their group (in some age groups also the best of third-placed teams - BO3rd) will continue to the play-offs.

#### Abschnitt (d) Best of third-placed teams (BO3rd)

In some age groups a certain number of the best of third placed teams will continue to play in the play-offs. The ranking of these best of third-placed teams is based on the score ratio (i.e. score made divided by score received) of the games vs. first and second team in the group.

#### Abschnitt (e) Points and Ranking

The league table ranking is calculated according to the following system:

Win	2 points
Loss	1 point
Forfeit	0 points

The ranking occurs on the basis of the FIBA rules:

#### Abschnitt (f) Ranking according to league table points:

If two or more teams are even on points, the points from the games of the teams against each other only are calculated for ranking. If teams are still equal in points, the score ratio (i.e. score made divided by score received) of the games of the teams against each other is calculated for ranking. If teams are still equal, the score ratio of all games is calculated for ranking. If teams are still equal, the score made from all games is used for ranking. If teams are still equal, the ranking is decided by drawing lots.

The game will be rated 2:0 if the opponent team does not show up until 5 minutes after the game officially starts.

#### Abschnitt (g) Draw

„Sudden Death“ will be played within the pre-rounds. This means that the first team that scores wins the game. The overtime starts with a jump ball. After the first round, overtimes will replace the “Sudden Death” until one team wins the game, and they (each of them) will last 2 minutes.

The organization is not able to provide balls for the warm up or even the games itself! Each team has to have at least one ball provided for each game.

#### Abschnitt (c)      Basket height

All age groups play on the standard basket height of 3.05m.

#### Abschnitt (d)      Uniforms

The FIBA rules apply: The first team named in the game plan (home team) shall wear light-colored shirts (preferably white). The second team named in the game plan (visiting team) shall wear dark-colored shirts.

If two teams have the same color of uniforms the team with the wrong-colored shirts has 3 minutes to change the color. Refusing to change the uniforms leads to a win for the other team.

#### Unterpunkt 3.04      Digital scoresheet

Games will be recorded on a digital scoreboard. The names of all players must be entered on the tournament platform in advance. Before each match, the coach can select the players who will play in the match directly at the scorer's table.

A match report in paper form is no longer available.

## Menüpunkt 4.      Rules

Deviations or modifications of the tournament rules are not valid even if both teams agree on the terms. The tournament will be held according to the FIBA rules as published officially on the FIBA website: [www.fiba.com](http://www.fiba.com). Divergent rules apply as follows:

#### Abschnitt (a)      Game restrictions

- 4 personal fouls
- 3 team fouls per quarter
- 2 time-outs per half

#### Abschnitt (b)      Zone-/ Man-2-Man Defense

Man-2-Man Defense obligation for age groups U14, U13 and U12!

Violations will be prosecuted after one warning with a free-throw and a throw-in at the center line for the opponent team. At repeated obvious violation, a technical foul shall be charged against the coach (C-foul).

The assessment is at the discretion of the referee.

#### Abschnitt (c)      24- Second- rule

The 24-second rule is at the discretion of the referee.

Also, the reset of the 24-second clock to 14 seconds in the case of a foul, a violation or rebounds by the team in possession of the ball is at the discretion of the referee.

#### Abschnitt (d) Disqualification

For Coaches and Players:

A disqualified foul ('D') leads to an immediate disqualification of the current game and a disqualification for the next game.

Depending on the force of the foul the organizer reserves the right to pronounce an exclusion from the tournament.

#### Abschnitt (e) Substitution

Player substitutions are possible at any time of the game without referee confirmation. The substitution has to take place at the middle line next to the scorer table. The substitute needs to wait until the player left the court at the middle line before he/she can go in and become a player. An infringement will be punished with a technical foul for the Coach ('C').

### Unterpunkt 4.02 Special Tournament Rules

#### Abschnitt (a) Special Rules for U12

- Ball Size 5
- Man-2-Man Defense
- Backcourt violation (a live ball in the frontcourt may not be played back to backcourt)
- Free Throws at 4 meters (normal 5.8m)
- 4 x 6 minutes stopped: (3 minutes halftime break)
- 2 Timeouts per half
- No 3-point shots
- No full court press allowed! Throw-in must be guaranteed. Defense can start at free throw line.

#### Abschnitt (b) Points of emphasis for man to man defense

Age groups U12, U13 and U14

**Every team has to apply the following points in order to play a regular man to man defense:**

- Every player has to guard one opponent
- The defensive order has to be visible for everybody
- Defensive players away from the ball are allowed to fall back between both baskets. They are not allowed to fall back further. On penetrations, double team situations or rebounding situations they are allowed to help out.
- The defense on the ball-side („strong-side“) has to play defense within two meters.

**The following is allowed on a man-to-man defense:**

- Double team on the ball or in the low post – if the double team is cleared out after the situation.
- Switch defenders during the defense.
- Fall back to the center of the court (between the two baskets on the weak side). If the weak side becomes the strong side, the defense has to guard his opponent within two meters.

**The following points are not allowed in a man-to-man defense:**

- The same two defenders are not allowed to double team on the ball the whole time, if the ball is passed.
- Switch the defense order very often in a very short notice (a few seconds)
- Stay under the basket – in the 3 second zone the whole time (the player's size is not important in this point)

**Consequence:**

If a team is not playing man to man defense a warning should be given to the team. On every following violation a free throw plus the inbound at the center line is given to the opponent team.

If one team is not playing man to man defense on purpose a technical foul may be given to the coach (C-foul).

**Unterpunkt 4.03 Referees**

The referee must be on the court at least 10 minutes BEFORE the game starts. If only one (or no) arbitrator is present at this time, the hall manager (hall security) is allowed to look for a replacement. This substitute (these substitutes) may referee the game if the scheduled referee has not arrived 5 minutes AFTER the scheduled start of the game.

**Unterpunkt 4.04 10 Protest**

A protest has to be submitted latest 60 minutes after the game at the gym supervisor. The protest fee of EUR 100 has to be paid at the same time. If the protest is granted, the fee will be refunded.

There is no right of appeal against the verdict of the arbitration tribunal and no refund if the protest is declined.
